



## “IRP Workshops on Disaster Recovery Planning”

The IRP designed a strategy to reach clients – disaster prone developing countries. A four day event is organized with senior government officials of the target country. The first day is utilized to visit a recovery project of an IRP partner. This gives an understanding of the context and challenges of recovery. Usually, the visit includes discussions with local government officials.



The next three days involve intensive deliberations. The cases in the guidance notes are discussed. These are the cases and stories provided by IRP partners. The participants discuss each case and relate to their own experiences. The participants are explained the tools developed by IRP partners, the technical support the partners can provide and the support the partners provide to developing countries. The participants are informed they can receive help for livelihoods recovery through ILO for the LAT, for governance and gender issues and checklists, amongst others, from UNDP, and so on. The objective is to familiarize the participants and the governments they represent, with the plethora of tools, checklists, guidelines available from the IRP partners. The event may be termed training, capacity building, etc. but in reality it constitutes a dissemination of the knowledge base of the platform.

Participants were provided copies of guidance notes on recovery, presentations, post-disaster scenarios, and a CD/USB with all relevant materials and many additional references on recovery. All material is from IRP partners and local offices of partners played a leading role in the discussions. Below is a list of workshops on disaster recovery planning organized to disseminate the Guidance Notes.
